This property offers a unique opportunity in North Carolina's Outer Banks, one of the most popular tourist destinations in the state. Long-term leases to an adventure park and a jet-ski rental operation provide income from the undevelopable marshland adjoining Pamlico Sound. A 3,100-square-foot retail and restaurant building, miniature golf course and asphalt parking lot convey. And with C-2 zoning within both the "Hotel" and "Commercial-outdoor recreational uses" overlay districts, a location on Pamlico Sound adjoining The Soundside event site with the potential for ocean views, and a positive study of hotel business potential in place, the property allows for numerous redevelopment possibilities now or in the future.



Christened "The Soundside" after completion of the first phase of improvements in 2015, this 10-acre outdoor event venue has become a significant regional amenity. Major events such as the Seafood Festival and OBX Brewtag, fairs, and private events fill its calendar through and beyond beach season, attracting numerous visitors to the property's doorstep. Future development phases will bring further improvements including an open-air pavilior and a boardwalk that will connect to the one existing on the property.

With fewer than 3,000 permanent residents and more than 300,000 annual visitors, Nags Head is at the heart of the Outer Banks. Along with miles of wide, warm beaches on the Atlantic Ocean, Nags Head is home to Jockey's Ridge State Park, where hikers, hang-gliders and kayakers enjoy the highest natural sand dune system in the Eastern U.S.; the northern entrance to Cape Hatteras National Seashore, which extends over 70 miles south to Hatteras and Ocracoke islands; Jennette's Pier, a \$25 million, 1,000 foot fishing pier, event and educational venue owned by the North Carolina Aquarium System. Nags Head is also home to the Bodie Island Lighthouse, which has shined a light on nearby waters since 1872 and is now operated by the National Park Service within the Cape Hatteras National Seashore. The town hosts national retailers at the Outer Banks Mall, premium outlets at Tanger Outlets Nags Head, the only hospital on the Outer Banks, and an abundance of locally owned shops and restaurants serving tourists and locals alike.
