




In the identified area, the current year population is 208,928. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 197,251. The rate of change since 2010 was 0.92% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 219,284 representing a change of 0.97% annually from 2016 to 2021. Currently, the population is 48.6% male and 51.4% female.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 5.3% of the population in the identified area compared to 17.9% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 57.2 in the identified area, compared to 63.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$66,654 in the area, compared to \$54,149 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$76,647 in five years, compared to \$59,476 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$83,837 in this area, compared to \$77,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$91,390 in five years, compared to \$84,021 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$31,102 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$29,472. The per capita income is projected to be \$33,820 in five years, compared to \$32,025 for all U.S. households

Currently, 69.9% of the 80,669 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 25.4%, renter occupied; and 4.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 76,619 housing units in the area - 70.7% owner occupied, 24.4% renter occupied, and 4.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.32%. Median home value in the area is \$199,183, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.78% annually to \$228,471.
