

Currently, 59.8% of the 113,202 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.7%, renter occupied; and 7.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 109,566 housing units in the area - 60.1% owner occupied, 32.6% renter occupied, and 7.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.46%. Median home value in the area is \$215,186, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.07% annually to \$250,336.




2015 Household Income







Population by Age







Population by Age
