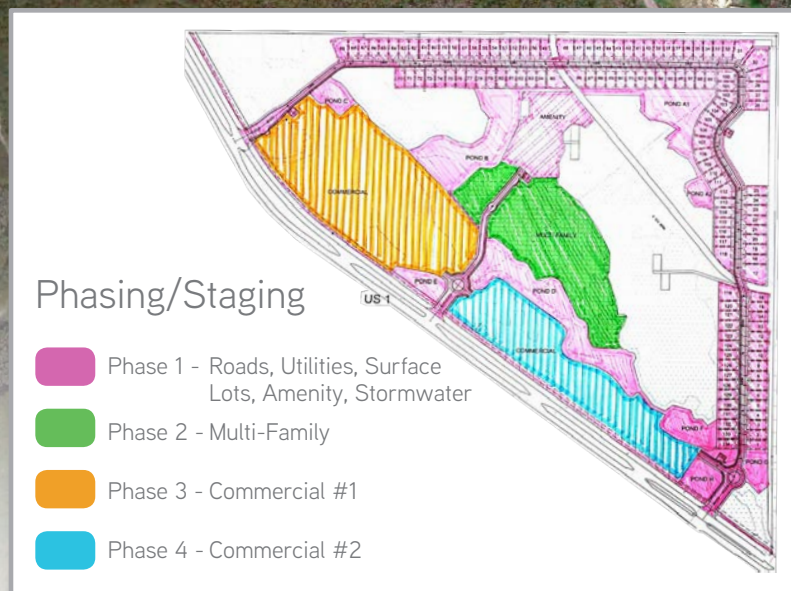

## PALM COAST 145, LLC CONCEPTUAL MASTER PLAN



**The City of Palm Coast** has 77,068 residents, according to the annual population estimate by the Bureau of Economic Business Research (BEBR). The City's population has grown 12 percent since 2006, and projections show the number of Palm Coast residents will more than double by the year 2035.

Data from the last U.S. Census, conducted in 2010, and the 5-Year American Community Survey shows the median age in Palm Coast is 45.1. Twenty-three percent of the City's residents are 65 and older, while 21.4 percent are under 18.

Within the Comprehensive Plan is a Vision Statement created by the citizens of Palm Coast over the course of several public workshops on the Comprehensive Plan. The Vision Statement summarizes the City's ideal future — a future that focuses on preserving and enhancing the natural environment and quality of life that initially attracted the City's residents.
