


Lower Level Floor Plan



PROPERTY HIGHLIGHTS

- > Bridging Euclid and Superior Avenues, The Arcade is centrally located in the heart of Cleveland's Historic Gateway District the center of downtown's retail shopping experience
- > An architectural treasure, one of the nation's first indoor shopping malls
- > Home to the recently-renovated 293-room Hyatt Regency Cleveland
- > 1,349+ SF available on Superior Avenue
- > A variety of small and mid-sized retail and office spaces available, all uniquely positioned under one roof
- > Within walking distance of major attractions and entertainment destinations including E. 4th St., House of Blues, Quicken Loans Arena, PlayhouseSquare, JACK Casino, Progressive Field, Huntington Convention Center of Cleveland, Global Center for Health Innovation and more
- > Free trolley lines stop directly outside Euclid and Superior entrances, operating until 11pm, 7 days a week

DEMOGRAPHICS | DOWNTOWN CLEVELAND

- > Downtown's residential occupancy is at 94.5%; population expected to reach 23,000 by 2020
- > Millennial and Boomer Generations make up the fastest growing segments of the Downtown CLE population
- > Cleveland ranked 7th fastest-growing population of workers with advanced degrees in the nation
- > 10th most walkable city in the United States (George Washington University Center for Real Estate and Urban Analysis)
- > Most walkable neighborhood in Northeast Ohio, with more transit options than anywhere else in the state
- > 4th Least Expensive City to Open a Business (KPMC City)
