

Currently, 74.6% of the 30,035 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 21.2%, renter occupied; and 4.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 28,163 housing units in the area - 74.1% owner occupied, 21.1% renter occupied, and 4.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.90%. Median home value in the area is \$293,055, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.91% annually to \$354,958.







Population by Age

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





Population by Age







Population by Age
