

In the identified area, the current year population is 29,288. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 26,235. The rate of change since 2010 was 1.53% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 31,603 representing a change of 1.53% annually from 2017 to 2022. Currently, the population is 49.7% male and 50.3% female.

The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 22.5 in the identified area, compared to 64.0 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 83.6% of the 10,403 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 13.8%, renter occupied; and 2.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 9,553 housing units in the area - 83.1% owner occupied, 12.4% renter occupied, and 4.5% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.86%. Median home value in the area is \$278,683, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.44% annually to \$314,400.
