


Currently, 73.1% of the 52,277 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 22.8%, renter occupied; and 4.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 48,498 housing units in the area - 73.7% owner occupied, 21.8% renter occupied, and 4.5% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.39%. Median home value in the area is \$258,717, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.15% annually to \$287,683.


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




2017 Household Income


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









2017 Household Income


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









2017 Household Income
