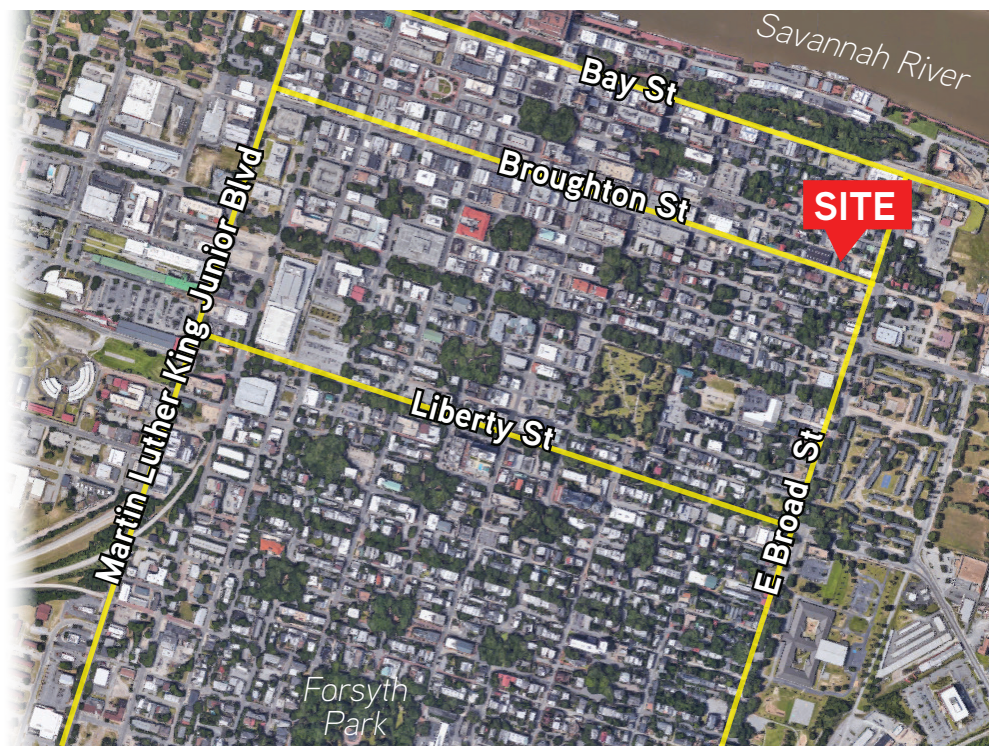

Savannah's East End

Savannah's east end is experiencing tremendous re-development and urban in-fill development as Savannah continues to grow.

TRUSTEES GARDEN (THE CHARLES MORRIS CENTER) is a destination event venue located at the end of Broughton Street on East Broad behind the Pirates House. Existing buildings include the Charles H. Morris Center and the Kehoe Building which is currently under renovation. Construction has started to expand the gardens to include an outdoor amphitheater and marketplace. Once completed the Trustees Garden is expected to be the areas premier venue for high-class events and gatherings.

THE SAVANNAH RIVER LANDING, is a ± 57 acre site that will include over $\pm 100,000$ SF of retail and office space, at least two new hotels, multi-family apartment complexes, along with single-family homes on the river. The subject property is approximately ± 0.3 miles from this development. Publicity around the development has been high and construction is expected to begin in 2018.
