# Washington County, Utah

Located in the southwestern corner of Utah, Washington County comprises the St. George Metropolitan Statistical Area.

### Demographics

In 2025 Washington County had an estimated a population of 214,323 people with a median age of 39 and a average household income of \$107,691. In the next 5 years the population is expected to grow by more than 38,641 people, a 18.1% increase, or 3.37% per year.

### Highlights

- From 2020-2024, St. George ranked as the #4 fastest-growing MSA in the U.S., by percentage. Adding over 27,000 people since 2020, a 11.85% increase over the past four years, Washington County's population continues to grow at near this same pace, at about 3.6% annually.
- St. George was ranked as the second best-performing small city by The Milken Institute in 2025.
- St. George was also awarded the #2 best small city for starting a business by WalletHub.
- Aviation, Healthcare, Education and Tourism are major industries in Washington County.
