FLORIDA'S SPACE COAST

- Brevard County Florida has a robust diversified regional economy led by aerospace, military installations, and tourism – closest beach to Orlando and surging cruise port
- Major area corporations with high paying jobs and lodging demand include Harris Corp., SPACEX, Northrop Grumman, Rockwell Collins, United Launch Alliance, Boeing, and Blue Origin. Since the Space Shuttle program concluded its final mission in July 2011, the US space program has effectively transitioned from government to private sector. Private rocket launches are now frequent and numerous. The return of manned launches is expected in the next few years
- Cocoa Beach-area military bases: Patrick Air Force Base, Cape Canaveral Air Station and Naval Ordnance Test Unit (NOTU) provide local economy more than \$1B benefit annually
- Port Canaveral is rivaling Miami and Fort Lauderdale as the busiest cruise port in the world. Proximity to Orlando International Airport (MCO) is a factor in Port's success, although many "Cruisers" drive-to their embarkation and are apt to stay in area hotels to enhance/extend their vacation "pre and/or post cruise".
