



- 5th largest town in Wake County
- 80% of homes in Holly Springs are owned rather than rented the highest rate among the state metro areas that were studied

DEVELOPMENT

• The Triangle Expressway opened on Highway 55 in Holly Springs, connecting Holly Springs to RTP, which reduces commute time to 15 minutes

- Holly Springs boasts 6 schools 3 elementary schools, 2 middle schools, and 1 high school, with 3 new schools planned for construction. The schools are part of the Wake County Public School System, which is consistently ranked among the top public school systems in the nation
- Holly Springs High School is one of the top schools in the nation, top 6% of high schools in the US Newsweek Magazine
- A 15-mile radius around Holly Springs stretches to Downtown Raleigh, Apex, Cary, Morrisville, and into Research Triangle Park.
- This 15-mile radius consists of a population of 350,000 and a work force of 180,000
- Major Holly Springs Employers include Segirus, GMA Supply, OFM, Inc, Rovisys, Pierce Group Benefits, Ideal Landscaping and Rex Healthcare

ATTRACTIONS

• Parrish Womble Park: The Town purchased this 46-acre site in 1997 and expansion was completed in fall 2013. Facilities include four baseball/ softball fields, a multi-purpose field for sports such as soccer and lacrosse, tennis courts, and other facilities.

• **Ting Park:** The 1,800 seat multi-sport stadiumwith synthetic turf field is used by Town football,baseball, lacrosse and soccer programs; Holly Springs Salamanders collegiate summer baseball; and for rentals, concerts, festivals and other events.
