


Currently, 55.7% of the 10,016 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.5%, renter occupied; and 12.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 9,270 housing units in the area - 57.7% owner occupied, 30.0% renter occupied, and 12.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.50%. 




2017 Household Income






